Our staff are the heart of Trust Care, and July was a month of growth and learning.

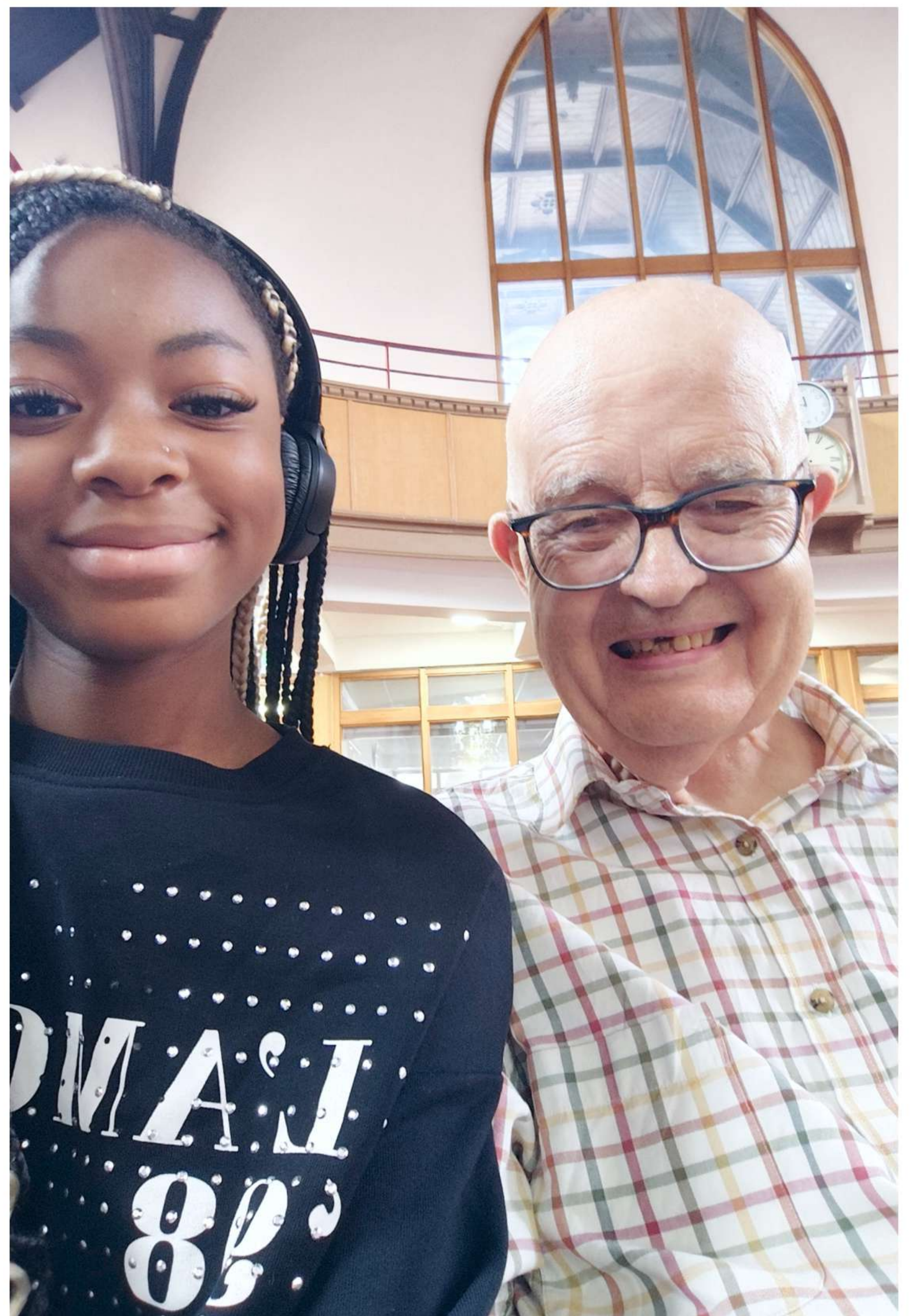
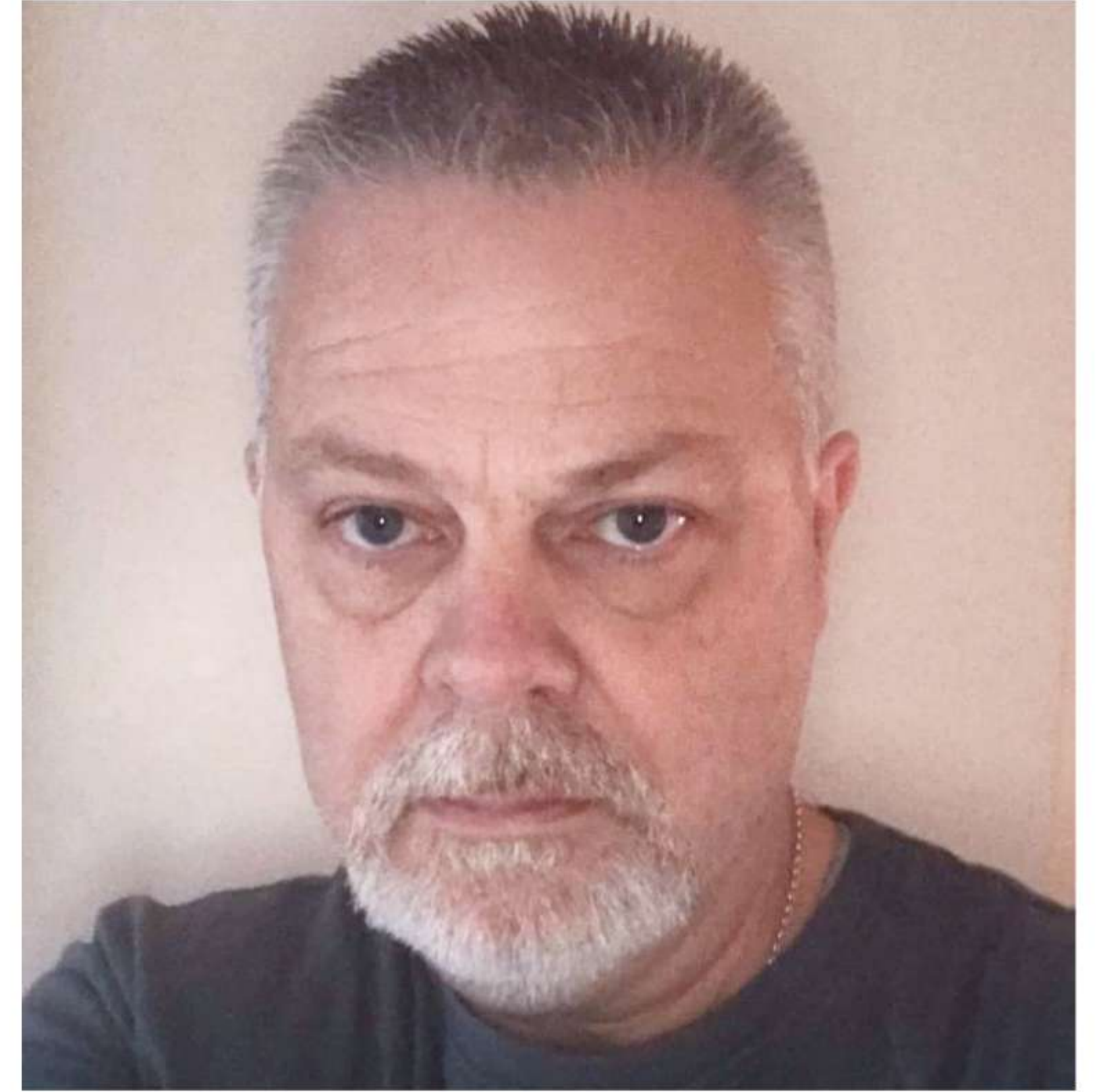
Lanrick House marked staff birthdays, showing appreciation with thoughtful gifts and heartfelt thanks.
